An Act relative to admission requirements for public institutions of higher education.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Chapter 15A of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section 30, as  
2   appearing in the 2018 Official Edition, and inserting in place thereof the following section:-

3           Section 30. No applicant shall be required to take any standardized college entrance  
4   aptitude test to gain admittance to any public institution of higher education in the  
5   commonwealth, as defined in section 5; provided, that applicants may submit results from a  
6   standardized test for admissions purposes if they so choose.
