## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Section 37. In making decisions relating to admissions, scholarships and grants, any

Chapter 69 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-
