In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to establishing a tuition free program for teachers and paraprofessionals.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 19 of Chapter 15A of the Massachusetts General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-
- 3 The Board of Higher Education shall institute, in conjunction with the Board of
- 4 Education, a program to allow any public school teacher or paraprofessional presently working
- 5 in the Commonwealth to attend courses at public institutions of Higher Education in the
- 6 Commonwealth at no tuition cost.
