## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to showing residential property.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 15B of chapter 186 of the General Laws or any
- 2 other special or general law to the contrary, no lessor, including but not limited to the owner,
- 3 landlord or any agent thereof, may enter or seek to enter the premises of occupied residential real
- 4 property for the purpose of showing said premises to a prospective tenant, purchaser, mortgagee
- 5 or any agent thereof for the duration of the governor's March 10, 2020 declaration of a state of
- 6 emergency.
