### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to service of civil process fees.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

#### 1 SECTION 1:

- 2 Chapter 262 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition, is hereby
- 3 amended, in Section 8, subsection (a) by striking out sub, subsections (1) and (2) and inserting
- 4 in place thereof the following sections:-
- 5 (1) for service of an original summons, trustee process, subpoena or scire facias, either by
- 6 reading it or by leaving a copy thereof, \$30 for each defendant upon whom service is made,
- 7 except as otherwise provided herein;
- 8 (2) for service of an original summons and complaint for divorce or for any other service
- 9 required to be served in hand, \$45 for each defendant upon whom service is made;
