An Act relative to selling tattooing, branding, body piercing kit or device to an unlicensed body art practitioner or minor.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 111 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the  
2 following section:-

3 230. Whoever gives or sells a tattooing, branding, or body piercing kit or other tattooing,  
4 branding, or body piercing device to an unlicensed body art practitioner or a minor shall be  
5 subject to a fine of not more than \$500.
