**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court  
(2021-2022)**

An Act limiting the use of prison labor.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 125 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition, is hereby  
2 amended by adding the following section:-

3 Section 22. No administrator or superintendent of any correctional institution, including  
4 any correctional facility, county correctional facility, penal institution, state correctional facility,  
5 state prison, or jail, shall transfer any inmate or prisoner outside of the commonwealth; and no  
6 inmate or prisoner of any correctional institution, including any correctional facility, county  
7 correctional facility, penal institution, state correctional facility, state prison, or jail, shall be  
8 transferred outside of the commonwealth, for the purpose of engaging in labor outside of the  
9 commonwealth.
