## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act to increase the penalty for school tardiness.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of Chapter 76 of the General Laws is hereby amended in line 5 by

2 striking out the words "be punished by a fine of not more than twenty dollars" and inserting in

- 3 place thereof the following words:- "be punished by a fine of not more than fifty dollars for each
- 4 day that the child does not attend school."
