An Act relative to civil rights.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11I of chapter 12 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “damages.” the following:-

3 In an action brought under this section against a person or entity acting under color of
4 law, proof shall not be required that the interference or attempted interference was by threats,
5 intimidation or coercion.
