- 1 SECTION 1. Section 11I of chapter 12 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "damages." the following:-
- In an action brought under this section against a person or entity acting under color of
- 4 law, proof shall not be required that the interference or attempted interference was by threats,
- 5 intimidation or coercion.
