An Act requiring the relocation of the Cambridge District Court.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the court administrator of the
- 2 executive office of the trial court shall, not later than December 31, 2021, relocate the Cambridge
- 3 district court, also known as the Third district court of eastern Middlesex, from the city of
- 4 Medford to the city of Cambridge.
