#### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to annoying telephone calls.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 269 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after
- 2 section 14B the following section:-
- 3 Section 14C. Whoever allows his telephone to be used by another to telephone a person
- 4 or his family, repeatedly, for the sole purpose of harassing, annoying or molesting that other
- 5 person or his family or for the purpose of repeatedly using indecent or obscene language to that
- 6 person or his family, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500 or by imprisonment for
- 7 not more than 3 months, or both.
