**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act relative to veterans and habitual offenders.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 25 of Chapter 279 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition,
2 is hereby amended in line (...) of subsection (a) by inserting after the words "provided by law"
3 the words:-"No sentence imposed under this subsection shall be reduced or suspended nor shall
4 such person so sentenced be eligible for probation, parole, work release or furlough or receive
5 any deduction from such person's sentence for good conduct."
