Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting in line 15, at the beginning of paragraph (1), the

- 4 SECTION 2. Said section 14 of said chapter 269 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is
- 5 hereby further amended by inserting in line 30, after the word "threat", the following: , or
- 6 knowingly communicates a false report of an active shooting at a school,
