An Act to grant co-op’s equal business opportunity.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1 of chapter 94G of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 25 of  
2 chapter 55 of the acts of 2017, is hereby amended in the definition of “craft marijuana cultivator  
3 cooperative” by striking out the words “to marijuana establishments but not to consumers” and  
4 inserting in place thereof the following words: “to those entities or individuals authorized by law  
5 or regulation to receive such deliveries.
