**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act protecting an employee's right to rebuttal of personnel records.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 148A of Chapter 149 of the Massachusetts General Laws, as appearing in the
2 2018 official edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end of the first sentence the
3 following, “or under the personnel records provisions in Section 52C of this chapter.”

4 Section 150 of said Chapter 149 of the Massachusetts General Laws, as appearing in the
5 2018 official edition, is hereby amended in the second paragraph by inserting after “33E” the
6 following, “52C”
