*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 27D of Chapter 149 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, after the words “the installation of resilient  
3 flooring in” in line 5, the following words, “the inspection, testing and repair of fire protection  
4 systems.”
