An Act relative to relief for the Municipal Affordable Housing Trust Fund.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 55C of chapter 44 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 inserting the following subsection:-

3 (k) The trust is exempt from chapter 149, sections 26 and 27, and from any other  
4 provisions concerning the Prevailing Wage Law establishing minimum wage rates for workers  
5 on public construction projects.
