3 Section 2A. In addition to the powers set forth in section 2, and notwithstanding section 3

4 of chapter 12 or any other law to the contrary, the child advocate, or the child advocate's

5 designee, may represent, appear, intervene in or bring an action on behalf the commonwealth or

6 of any child in any proceeding before any state or federal court, tribunal, agency, board or

7 commission in which matters related to this chapter are in issue.
