**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act relative to safe traffic direction.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 6B of Chapter 40 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition,
2 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:--

3 A city or town which accepts this section shall require uniforms, for the uniformed
4 members of its police force purchased using appropriated funds, to include a pair of white gloves
5 for use while directing traffic. Members of said police force shall wear white gloves at all times
6 when directing traffic.
