By Mr. Vitolo of Brookline, a petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2211) of Tommy Vitolo and David Allen Robertson relative to municipal parking permit fees. Municipalities and Regional Government.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act relative to parking permit fees.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Any municipality operating a permit program for the parking of motor
2 vehicles shall not charge, for the purpose of acquiring a parking permit for a duration of between
3 2 days and 366 days, in excess of a daily limit of \$7 for each day of said permit's validity.

4 SECTION 2. The daily limit established in Section 1 of this act shall be increased by
5 \$0.50 on December 31 of each year.

6 SECTION 3. Section 1 of this act shall apply to permits granted after January 1, 2022

7 SECTION 4. Section 2 of this act shall go into effect beginning January 1, 2022.
