An Act relative to CNA training.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 official edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by inserting after section 40 the following new section:-
- 3 Section 4P. For Certified Nurse Aides (CNA) who receive their CNA training and work
- 4 in nursing facilities whose resident population is predominantly non-English speaking, the Nurse
- 5 Aide Certification Exam shall be offered in other languages including Spanish and Chinese.
