An Act relative to firearm licensing renewals during a state of emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. During a pandemic or other state of emergency in which police departments  
2 are not processing applications for gun license renewals, expiring or expired licenses which  
3 occurs or occurred during the state of emergency will be valid until the renewal can be fully  
4 processed or denied by the police department. This provision shall not prevent the Chief of  
5 Police’s authority in taking a firearms license away should circumstances warrant as already  
6 appearing in the MGL.
