An Act relative to the retirement system.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 105 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 striking subsections (b) and (c) and inserting the following new language:-

3 (b) A member shall be entitled to creditable service resulting from his reinstatement  
4 service upon the completion of payments required under subsection (a) and payment of regular  
5 deductions under section 22 for the reinstatement service. In the event that a retirement  
6 allowance becomes effective for the member before the completion of payments under  
7 subsection (a), the member shall be entitled to credit for that proportion of reinstatement service  
8 as the board shall prescribe, in addition to any credit for service rendered prior to the date of  
9 reinstatement, provided that the member would have otherwise been eligible for that prior  
10 service.
