An Act relative to contributory retirement board elections.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 20 of chapter 32 of the General Laws is amended by inserting at
- 2 the end of subdivision (4 7/8E) the following new subdivision:-
- 3 (4 7/8F) A surviving spouse who is receiving a retirement allowance from a contributory
- 4 retirement system established under the provisions of sections one to twenty-eight, inclusive,
- 5 shall be entitled to vote in the election of the third and fourth members serving on the board of
- 6 such contributory retirement system.
- 7 SECTION 2. Paragraph (h) of section 19 of chapter 34B is amended by inserting at the
- 8 end of the ninth sentence thereof the following words:-
- 9 and surviving spouses who are receiving a retirement allowance from a contributory
- retirement system established under the provisions of this chapter.

- SECTION 3. Paragraph (i) of section 19A of chapter 34B is amended by inserting at the end of the ninth sentence thereof the following words:-
- 13 , and surviving spouses who are receiving a retirement allowance from a contributory 14 retirement system established under the provisions of this chapter.
- SECTION 4. The provisions of this act shall take effect on January 1, 2022.
