**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act to extend veterans retirement buyback opportunities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The first sentence of the fourth paragraph of subsection (h) of section 4 of
2 chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the words “four years
3 provided” and inserting in place thereof the following words:- 10 years; provided.

5 SECTION 2. The third sentence of the fourth paragraph of subsection (h) of section 4 of
6 chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the words “five years guard
7 service or five years active reserve service” and inserting in place thereof the following words:- 4
8 years guard service or 4 years active reserve service.
