In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act regarding spouses as caregivers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 9 of Chapter 118E is hereby amended by adding in the second
- 2 sentence of the second paragraph, after the words "requirements for Title XIX" the following
- 3 new language:--
- 4 "Any program of home and community based services funded pursuant to the provisions
- 5 of this chapter or pursuant to the provisions of chapter one hundred and eighteen G, in which
- 6 family members are permitted to serve as paid caregivers, shall include spouses within the
- 7 definition of family member; provided further, that the Executive Office of Health and Human
- 8 Services shall file a state plan amendment or wavier application, as is required to allow spouses
- 9 to serve as paid caregivers."
