**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act regarding free tuition for students seeking a degree in criminal justice.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, an individual pursuing a
- 2 degree in criminal justice or a certificate in law enforcement at any college or university in the
- 3 Commonwealth shall receive from the Commonwealth full tuition reimbursement for his or her
- 4 course of studies.
