Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The second paragraph of section 45 of chapter 59 of the General Laws, as appearing in
- 2 the 2018 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:- Upon request,
- 3 the assessors shall redact an individual's name from any publicly available electronic books or
- 4 records; provided, however, that the redacted information shall be maintained in the assessors'
- 5 books or records and subject to public records requests pursuant to section 10 of chapter 66.
