In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to the electronic deposit of tax refunds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 85 of chapter 62C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the second sentence the following
- 3 sentence:-
- 4 For refunds processed electronically and paid through direct deposit, the commissioner
- 5 shall permit a taxpayer to elect to have his or her refund split and deposited into more than one
- 6 bank account, including, but not limited to higher education savings plans or accounts.
