### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to the assisted living programs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any special or general law, or rule or regulation to the
- 2 contrary, an assisted living program shall be eligible through Economic Assistance Coordinating
- 3 Council for a Tax Increment Financing allowing municipalities to provide flexible targeted
- 4 incentives to stimulate job-creating development.
