An Act relative to worker-owned cooperative enterprises.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 8 of Chapter 157 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the
2 phrase “organized under chapter one hundred and fifty-seven A,” the following:-

4 entities determined to meet the standard of a Worker-Owned Cooperative Enterprise
5 (WOCE) by the state’s Apex Industry Organization, being the national nonprofit association of
6 worker-owned businesses with the largest number of worker-owned firms in Massachusetts as its
7 members as determined by the Undersecretary of the Department of Housing and Community
8 Development (DHCD)
