*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Paragraph 2 of subsection (k) of section 6 of chapter 62 of the General Laws, as
- 2 appearing in the 2018 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the figure “\$750”, in
- 3 line 447, and inserting in place thereof the following words:- half of the total real estate tax bill.
