### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act establishing gender neutral bathrooms.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 142 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after
- 2 Section 13 the following section:-
- 3 Section 13a. The examiners shall promulgate regulations to allow gender neutral
- 4 bathrooms to be designed and installed in any use group defined by the 780 CMR Massachusetts
- 5 state building code regardless of whether the work being performed is new construction or
- 6 repair, renovation or alteration work.
