Barber for the issuance of an annual proclamation by the Governor setting apart the month of April as Sikh appreciation month and designate November 12 as world equality day. **In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act Recognizing Sikh Holidays.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 15IIIIII, the
2 following section:-

3 Section 15JJJJJ. The Governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart the
4 month of April as Sikh Appreciation Month in recognition of the significant contributions Sikhs
5 have made to the Commonwealth and to the United States. The Governor shall recommend that
6 said month be observed in an appropriate manner by the people. And the Governor shall
7 designate November 12, the anniversary of the birth of Guru Nanak, the founder of Sikhism, as
8 "World Equality Day"
