An Act authorizing the release of a restriction on certain parcels of land in Freetown.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to provide forthwith for the department of conservation and recreation to release a restriction on certain land in the town of Freetown, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the department of  
2 conservation and recreation shall release a restriction described in a deed recorded in the Bristol  
3 Fall River district registry of deeds in book 1039, page 432, upon the portion of the land  
4 described by deeds recorded in the Bristol Fall River district registry of deeds in book 8622, page  
5 93 and book 9987, page 122.
