An Act relative to certain truck transportation practices.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 19A of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the figure “eighty-five”, in line 8, the following  
3 words:- ; provided, that a truck or other motor vehicle in combination with a trailer with a total  
4 weight equal to or less than 99,000 pounds may travel on a public way with such a permit.
