**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court  
(2021-2022)**

An Act designating a certain bridge in the town of Auburn the Robert Conroy Memorial Bridge.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Bridge number A17035 (1QR), the I-290 east-bound bridge over Water  
2 Street in the Town of Auburn, shall be designated and known as the Robert Conroy Memorial  
3 Bridge in recognition of Robert Conroy. Conroy served his country during World War II and  
4 died in a 1945 battle in Italy. He was awarded a Purple Heart for his valor. The Massachusetts  
5 Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain a suitable marker bearing the designation  
6 in compliance with the standards of the department.
