**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act relative to bicycle safety.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1: Section 11B of chapter 85 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 71 and 72, the words “either a lamp
3 emitting a red light, or” and inserting in place thereof the following words: “a lamp emitting a
4 red light and.”

5 SECTION 2: Section 11B of chapter 85 of the General Laws is also hereby amended by
6 inserting a new subsection between subsection (9) and subsection (10), which will read: “No
7 retailer, distributor, wholesaler, or manufacturer in this state shall sell or offer for sale any
8 bicycle unless such bicycle is equipped with lamps and reflectors as required by Subsection (8)
9 and (9) of this Section.” SECTION 3: Subsection (11) of section 11B of chapter 85 of the

10 General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the
11 following words: “twenty dollars” and inserting the following words: “fifty dollars.”
