An Act relative to drivers licenses for international students.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. An international student, who is at least 18 years old, with an F-1 visa from  
2 one of the countries in Appendix “C” of the RMV regulations, who has obtained their  
3 Massachusetts drivers permit, may continue to legally drive on the roads of the Commonwealth  
4 on his or her own country’s valid license for an additional 45 days following the date on which  
5 they received their Massachusetts driving permit.
