**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act to preserve historic markers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. There shall be appropriated a specified amount of not more than \$200,000
2 for the Massachusetts Highway Department to pick-up, repaint, repair and refurbish the black
3 upright markers at historic places installed pursuant to chapter 10 of the resolves of 1930.
