**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act relative to penalties for unlawful passing of a school bus.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 14 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition,
2 is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 30 to 33, inclusive, the words: “\$250; and for a
3 second offense by a fine of not less than \$500 nor more than \$1,000; and for a third or
4 subsequent offense by a fine of not less than \$1,000 nor more than \$2,000” and inserting in place
5 thereof the following words:- \$350; and for a second offense by a fine of not less than \$600 nor
6 more than \$1,100; and for a third or subsequent offense by a fine of not less than \$1,100 nor
7 more than \$2,100.
