An Act increasing annuity for disabled veterans and gold star families.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 6b of chapter 115 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2021 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by striking out the word in line 3 of paragraph 2, “\$2,000” and inserting in  
3 place thereof the word: “\$3,000”.

4           Section 6b of chapter 115 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2021 Official Edition,  
5 is hereby amended by striking out the words in line 1 of paragraph 3, “provided that the  
6 surviving spouse does not remarry.”

7           Section 6b of chapter 115 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2021 Official Edition  
8 is hereby amended by striking out the word in line 3 of paragraph 3, “ \$2,000” and inserting in  
9 place thereof the word: “\$3,000”.
