**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act relative to the estate tax.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2A of chapter 65C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official
2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “commonwealth”, in line 3, the following
3 words:- ; provided, however, that no tax shall be imposed on the transfer of an estate valued at or
4 less than \$1,040,000.
