An Act exempting public school stadiums from certain state regulations.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. Chapter 142 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by inserting after section 13, the following new section:-

3           Section 13A. For the purposes of preventing unnecessary additional expenses to  
4 municipalities and school districts, public school athletic stadiums built prior to 2010 for the use  
5 of K-12 populations and are within 1000 feet of the main school building are exempt from  
6 Uniform State Plumbing Code 248 CMR 10.10:18.
