In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act exempting public school stadiums from certain state regulations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Chapter 142 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition, is
- 2 hereby amended by inserting after section 13, the following new section:-
- 3 Section 13A. For the purposes of preventing unnecessary additional expenses to
- 4 municipalities and school districts, public school athletic stadiums built prior to 2010 for the use
- 5 of K-12 populations and are within 1000 feet of the main school building are exempt from
- 6 Uniform State Plumbing Code 248 CMR 10.10:18.
