An Act relative to inspection station licenses.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 7W of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the figure “142M”, in line 8, the following  
3   words:- ; provided however, that the rules and regulations shall prioritize applications for the  
4   licensing of inspection stations in municipalities with fewer than 2 licensed inspection stations of  
5   the same class as the application.

6           SECTION 2. Said section 7W of said chapter 90, as so appearing, is hereby further  
7   amended by inserting after the second paragraph the following paragraph:-

8           The registrar shall not impose a limit on the number of inspection station licenses in the  
9   commonwealth.
