**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court  
(2021-2022)**

An Act directing the State Retirement Board to grant creditable service to Cheryl A. Bednarik.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the State  
2 Board of Retirement shall credit Cheryl A. Bednarik, an employee of the University of  
3 Massachusetts, with creditable service for the period of October 1, 1990 to October 1, 1994,  
4 inclusive, for the purpose of determining her superannuation retirement allowance pursuant to  
5 paragraph (a) of subdivision (2) of section 5 of chapter 32 of the General Laws. Before the date  
6 that any retirement allowance becomes effective in the case of Cheryl A. Bednarik, she shall pay  
7 into the annuity savings fund of the retirement system of the state in one (1) sum or installments,  
8 upon such terms and conditions as the board may prescribe, an amount equal to that which would  
9 have been withheld as regular deductions from her regular compensation for such previous  
10 service, plus buyback interest.
