An Act establishing Massachusetts Right Whale Day.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:

2 SECTION JJJJJ. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart April  
3 twenty-fourth as Right Whale Day to promote the preservation of the critically endangered North  
4 Atlantic Right Whale and recommending that said day be observed in an appropriate manner by  
5 the people.
