An Act re-designating a certain bridge in the city of Lawrence.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding Chapter 76 of the Acts of 1995, the following bridge is re-  
2 designated:

3           A)     The bridge on South Union Street between Merrimack Street and Market Street  
4 spanning railroad tracks in the city of Lawrence shall be re-designated and known as the Joseph  
5 A. Torrissi Memorial Bridge, in memory of Joseph A. Torrissi and his many contributions to the  
6 city of Lawrence. The department of highways shall erect suitable markers thereon bearing said  
7 designation in compliance with standards of said department.

8           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
